Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to an order of the City of Farmington, Arkansas, sealed bids will be received at the Farmington City Hall, 354 W. Main Street, Farmington, Arkansas 72730, until 9:00 AM on Thursday, March 31, 2016 for furnishing all tools, materials and labor, and performing the necessary work for construction of Double Springs Road Drainage Improvements. At this time the bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Farmington City Hall. The work generally consists of:

Constructing approximately 136 linear feet of 42 inch RCP with flared end sections, 18 inch concrete culvert replacements, construction of concrete headwalls, grading of ditch, construction of roadway shoulder, driveway repair, grouted rip-rap, tree removal, road stabilization remediation, seeding and mulching, clean-up, storm water pollution prevention, traffic maintenance, and every other item necessary for complete project.

Copies of these documents may be obtained from the office of said engineers upon request and upon the payment of \$75.00, which is not refundable.

The contractors shall make such inspection and studies of the site of the work as to familiarize themselves with all conditions to be encountered.

Each bid must include an acceptable statement of the bidder's qualifications. The requirements of the bidder's statement of qualifications will be furnished to prospective bidders with the specifications.

Each bid must be accompanied by an acceptable form of bid guaranty in the amount equal to at least five percent of the whole bid, and such bid bond or cashier's check shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bids must be made upon the official bid sheets contained in the specifications, and such bid sheets SHALL NOT be removed from the remainder of the Specifications and Contract Documents. All bids shall be sealed and the envelopes addressed to: Melissa McCarville, City of Farmington, 354 W. Main Street, Farmington, Arkansas. All bids shall be plainly marked on the outside of the envelope specifying that it is a bid for "Double Springs Road Drainage Improvements", the time for opening of bids, and the name and current contractor's license number of the bidder.

All bidders must be licensed under the terms of Act 150, Arkansas Acts of 1965, as amended.

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated 22-9-203, the Owner encourages all qualified small, minority, and women business enterprises to bid on and receive contracts for goods, services and construction. The Owner also encourages all general contractors to subcontract portions of their contract to qualified small, minority, and women business enterprises.

The City of Farmington reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality in the proposal deemed to be in the best interests of the Owner. The Owner further reserves the right to withhold the awarding of the contract for a period not to exceed 90 days after the receipt of bids.
